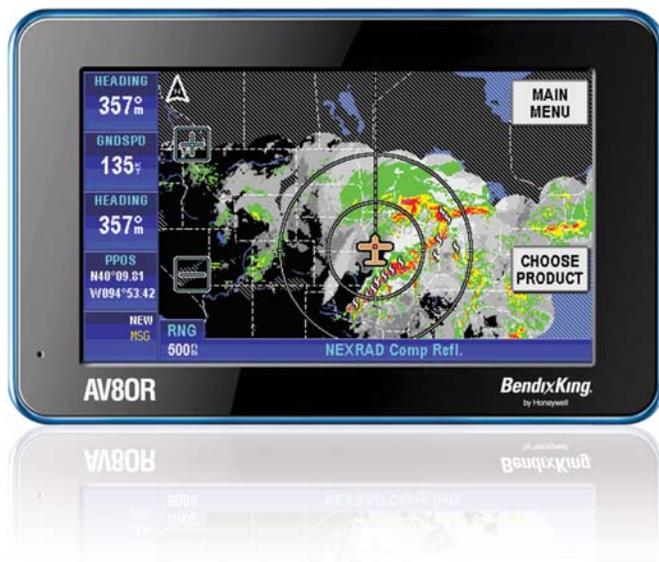


How to Pair Bluetooth device to an AV80R Handheld.



This is for AV80R Handheld owners looking to pair their Bluetooth device to the AV80R Handheld.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- AV80R Handheld
- Bluetooth enabled device

ONE

Ensure both the AV80R and the Bluetooth device are powered and running.

TWO

From the **AV80R MAIN MENU**, touch the **“SETTINGS”** soft key and then touch the **“Blue Tooth”** soft key to display the main **Bluetooth configuration** page:



THREE

Touch the **“Bluetooth Icon”** to open the **Bluetooth manager** page:



FOUR

Double tap on the **“Explore a Bluetooth Device”** option. This will initiate a search for Bluetooth devices. While the search is in progress, the following page is displayed:

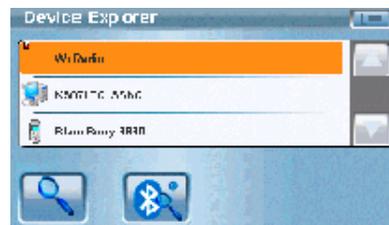


FIVE

Refer to your Bluetooth device's operator's guide for instruction on setting your device Bluetooth to the "Discover" mode

SIX

When the Bluetooth device has been found, highlight the item in the shortcut file and touch the soft key to access the device and display:



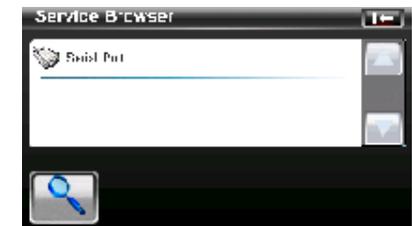
SEVEN

Enter the Passkey supplied with your device. If it is not available create your own 4 digit passkey and then touch OK. If your Bluetooth device requests a passkey, use the same one you entered for the AV80R:



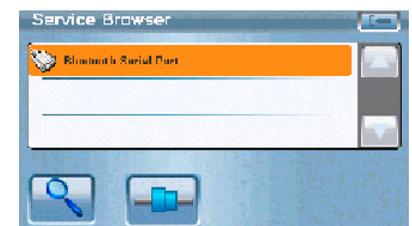
EIGHT

Touch the "Bluetooth Serial Port":



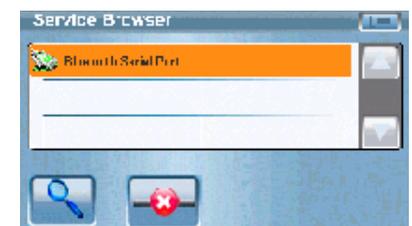
NINE

Touch the service to highlight and then click on the link icon



TEN

The page will look like the figure below once the Bluetooth devices paired:
